



Indiana Society Sons of the American Revolution Silver Indiana Service Medal Nomination

The silver medal denotes service at the district level and is certified by the state secretary or color guard commander. Compatriots must serve as district VP, major area color guard vice commander, or be the principal program at at least 2 chapter meetings (per year) outside their primary chapter. Ladies may qualify by completing at least 3 of the following each year: presenting a chapter program, serving as primary hostess for the Ladies Auxiliary meeting at one of the 4 annual state meetings, participating in 3 parades outside their home chapter, participating in colonial outfit at the Vincennes Rendezvous, Conner Prairie, or Feast of the Hunter's Moon SAR booths/displays, other displays or educational events outside their primary chapter, etc.
