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Greetings Compatriots of the SAR!

I was proud to be able to present the Indiana Annual Report at the SAR Central District Meeting held this last weekend (October 30). Our report highlighted our current initiatives: Grow new leaders, Grow our compatriot fellowship, Grow our knowledge of the Revolutionary War, Grow participation in youth programs, and Attract new members and retain current members.

I was very happy to report that our Indiana membership has increased **15%** over the past year, and we retained a significant percentage of existing members.

It was also very clear that work and activities we have performed in the past 12 months compare very favorably with our neighboring states (Ohio, Kentucky, and West Virginia). I thought this would be good opportunity to share some of the activities of the Indiana Society over the last year, so you can share in the pride I feel for the great work we do. Some of these activities were: participation in Veterans Day parades and Wreath across America ceremonies; participation in Memorial Day and 4th of July observances throughout the State; participation in numerous parades throughout the state; participation in monthly Naturalization ceremonies for new citizens; presentation of Flag Certificates to many individual and organizations for their patriotic display of the U.S. Flag; attendance at numerous school programs-public, private and home school groups to tell the story of the American Revolution; participation in the Vigil at Washington's tomb in Mount Vernon; support of the C.A.R both through interaction as well as monetary support; participation in the Wounded Warriors program; support of the DAR throughout the state with various joint programs; sponsorship of Youth Programs with the Middle School Brochure Contest, the Elementary School Poster Contest, the Eagle Scout Contest, JROTC programs, the Knight Essay Contest, the Rumbaugh Oration Contest; and participation in many Patriot Grave Markings throughout Indiana.

In addition, many members of the Indiana Society participated at several national events, including Fort Laurens in Ohio, Blue Licks in Kentucky and Point Pleasant in West Virginia. We also placed wreaths at the local battle commemoration of the De LaBalme massacre in Indiana.

Our Indiana Society members hold membership spots on numerous National Committees. With this involvement, our Society has an opportunity to help set the course for the future of the SAR.

I congratulate you and I ask you to keep up the good work. Your commitment helps us to fulfill the mission of the Sons of the American Revolution – "....to maintain and expand the meaning of patriotism, respect for our national symbols, the value of American citizenship, and the unifying force of 'e pluribus unum' that was created from the people of many nations -- one nation and one people."

Pictured below: "The Flag Lady" Shelly G Jones presented to the Continental Chapter, Sept 11, 2021 held in Muncie on a wide variety of historical flags. There were flags with words of faith, protest and resistance centered around the program. The first photo displays the Bedford Flag which is one of the earliest flags known to exist in the United States. It is the flag carried by Bedford Minuteman, Nathaniel Page, to the Concord Bridge on April 19, 1775, at the beginning of the American Revolution. The Latin inscription "Vince Aut Morire" means "conquer or die." The arm emerging from the clouds represents the arm of God. he second photo designates the Bunker Hill flag. Very nicely done!




